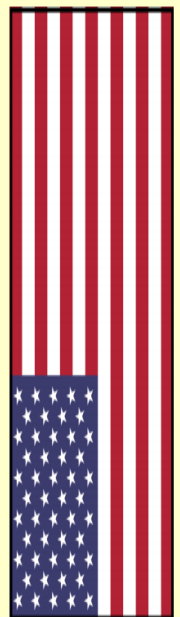
They have also been learning how to express how many of something there are. Here we see: hay seis lince (there are 6 lynx).

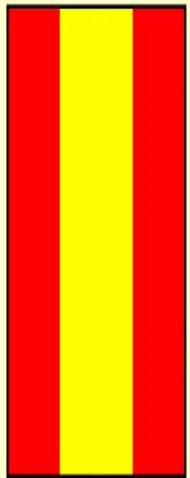

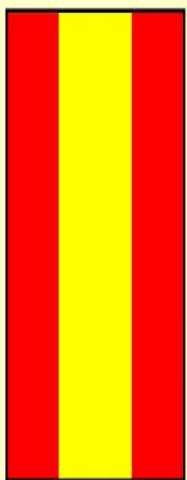
