Dear Stillness Families

The first coffee morning of the new academic year will take place on Friday, 24 September 2021 from 8.50am at the front of the junior school to, once again, support the Macmillan Cancer Charity's "World's Biggest Coffee Morning". If you bring your own cup we will be happy to provide the coffee and cake for a small donation!

The Macmillan Charity provides an enormous amount of care and support to people suffering from cancer and, as a school; we are hoping to raise a significant amount of money to help them.

- **£48** could help run the Macmillan forum for over 3 hours. Typically, that would give nearly 333 people affected by cancer both emotional and practical support.
- **£100** could pay for a person affected by cancer to attend a health and wellbeing event, providing them with skills to improve the management of these areas in their lives.
- **£285** could pay for a Macmillan grant that helps a family affected by cancer take a holiday and enjoy precious time together.
- **£573** could pay for a Macmillan Social Care Worker for a week, helping patients, family members and carers manage the social and practical problems of living with cancer.
- **£1148** could pay for a Macmillan nurse for a week, helping people living with cancer and their families receive essential medical, practical and emotional support.

Also on 24 September 2021, children and staff are permitted to come in to school wearing the colour "green" for a small donation.

Please be advised that all charity giving is optional and your child is under no obligation to take part.
