Another action packed week in Y6! Now that assessment week is over we were back to producing some fantastic work. In English, we started our new unit on setting descriptions using Dunkirk as a focus, this will continue into next week. In Maths, we finished our second fractions unit and have now started our next unit: converting measurements.

In PSHE, our unit on "Celebrating Difference" continued where we looked at celebrating differences, studying some inspiring Para-Olympians.
