Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to give you some further information about the upcoming Sports Day which will be on the days as stated below.

- Y3/4 – Monday 20th May 2024
- Y5/6 – Tuesday 21st May 2024

As the date nears, I wanted to provide some key information and an initial outline of the day. While we never know what the weather will be like, historically it has always been very hot. The event takes place at Kings Ground, where there is virtually no shade. As such, please, please, please ensure your child comes to school covered in sunscreen, with a hat and a full water bottle and in their PE kit. If your child would like to wear their house colour t-shirt they can. I would also advise that if you are coming to watch, which we very much hope you will, you also apply lots of sunscreen and bring water if hot!

This year, we will ask you to drop the children to school as normal. We will register the children, as normal, and then walk them down and get them ready. The attached timetable gives you a good idea of the itinerary for the day. Please bear in mind, these are estimated times and things will either go quicker than we expect or slower. The itinerary attached is very much for general guidance and things will change. You will be able to walk around the different stations to watch your child but we ask that you stand on the outside of the activity. **Unfortunately, the toilets are out of use for parents/carers as other schools are using King's ground on the same day.**

On each day, once the children's races are completed, there will be a parent race, a teacher's egg and spoon race and we will then host the closing ceremony. The event is planned to finish by lunchtime so those who need to, can go back to work and only need to book half a day off.
