Curriculum Enrichment: *Keha Seebii* at Catford Broadway Theatre

We are delighted to inform you that we have made plans for Y6 children to attend a matinee performance of *Keha Seebii* on 9 October 2025.

Venue: Catford Broadway Theatre

Date: 9 October 2025

Leaving school: 1.15pm

Lunch: We will have lunch at school as usual on this day.

Returning to school: We aim to return to school by the **slightly later time of 4pm.**

Travel arrangements: We will be travelling to and from the Theatre via bus (public transport).

Keha Seebii (meaning 'for those left behind') is a performance dedicated to a time in the borough of Lewisham's local history when 14 young people lost their lives in the tragic New Cross Fire of 1981. Using movement, dance, voice and percussive music, this performance explores the themes of grief, hope, love and compassion via a variety of cultural and social dances, rhymes and rhythms.

We are pleased to confirm that there is no cost to Y6 parents/carers for this unique curriculum enrichment experience.

Please note that without your consent, we are unable to take your child off-site.
